Inventions Presentation Guidelines

As you prepare for your Inventions Presentation, make sure that you cover the following topics.

- 1. Introduce yourself.
- 2. Say the name of your invention.
- 3. Tell what problem is solved by this invention.
- 4. Explain how you thought up this invention.
- 5. Explain the different steps you went through to design it.
- 6. Discuss and share your visual.
- 7. Ask the audience if they have any questions.
- 8. You can add any other information you feel is needed. These are only the minimum requirements!
